Promote India’s cultural richness through regional cuisines and attire.

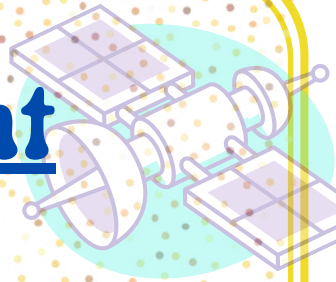
Encourage artistic expression via traditional art forms like Rangoli.

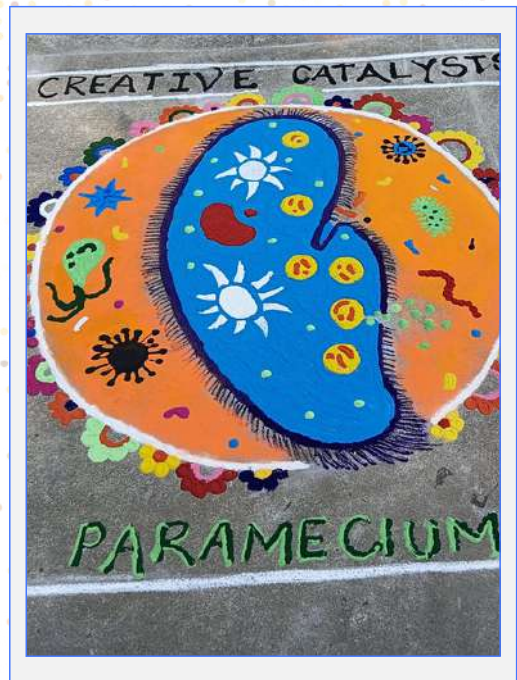


Program Highlights

Feedback from recipients indicated that the donated footwear significantly improved their comfort and mobility. 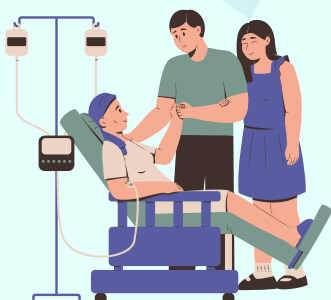

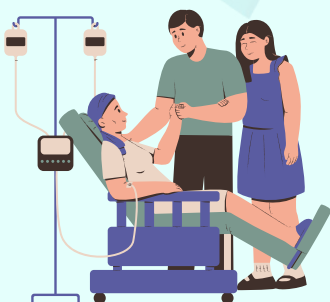


CANCER AWARENESS PROGRAM

- ✦ The community's warm response reflected a growing openness toward preventive healthcare.



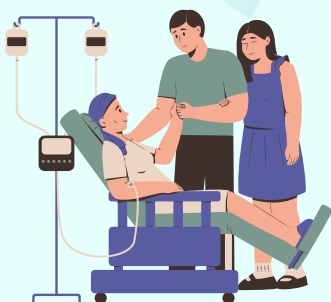
