AND

Department of Zoology, St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Ranchi. A Minority Educational Institution based on religion affiliated to Ranchi University. The College was founded by the Society of Jesus in 1944 with the primary objective of providing Higher Education in Christian atmosphere to all the deserving students with preferential option for the Christians, Schedule Tribe and Schedule Caste. - A. 2. Scope of Collaboration

2.6 Student Development and Entrepreneurship

3. Confidentiality

Both parties agree that any confidential information shared during the collaboration will not be disclosed to third parties without mutual consent. Intellectual property and research findings generated under this MoU will be appropriately credited to both parties.

4. Limitations

This MoU does not constitute a legal or financial obligation for either party. It serves as a framework for collaboration and can be amended through mutual agreement.

5. Costs

The parties agree to jointly seek funding from relevant stakeholders and organisations to support the objectives outlined in this MoU.

6. Duration

- This MoU will come into effect upon the date of signing by the representatives of both parties and will remain valid for five (5) years.
- It may be renewed or amended upon mutual consent, with a review conducted prior to the renewal.
- Either party may terminate this MoU by providing written notice at least three (3) months in advance.

6) Additional Terms

This Agreement will become effective upon the date of signature by both Parties. It shall remain valid for a period of five (05) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be modified by written mutual consent of both Parties. This Agreement may be terminated by either Party with advance written notice of at least thirty (30) days. Upon notice of termination both parties agree to work in good faith to enable visiting scholars to complete their respective research programs unhindered by the termination. The agreement may be extended by mutual consent of the two Parties after the five-year period, and it must be renewed in writing.
