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## Memorandum of Understanding

#### Between

St. Xaviers College, Ranchi

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<u>Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation</u>

<u>On a non judicial stamp paper with receipt nos</u>

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#### 1. Preamble:

St. Xavier's College, Ranchi is a Minority Educational Institution based on religion established and administered by the Ranchi Jesuit Province of the Society of Jesus. The College is registered by the Ranchi Province under the local title 'Xaviers Ranchi' under the Society's Registration Act XXI of 1860 and affiliated to Ranchi University Ranchi. St. Xavier's College, Ranchi is a premier institution of the State of Jharkhand, imparting quality education and has remained a centre of excellence till date. This is a minority educational institution. The University Grants Commission conferred Autonomous status in 2005 and granted "College with Potential for Excellence" status in 2006

Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation, a non-profit organization, a non-profit organisation registered under the Indian Society's Act, 1961, and having its Registered office at Firayalal Compound, Kadru Diversion Road, Opposite Radisson Blu, Main Road, Ranchi – 834001, Jharkhand (hereinafter referred to as 'Jharkhand Foundation') which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors or assigns. **Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation** is focussed on the prevention, care and cure of Thalassemia in Jharkhand, and has been actively involved in making blood and its components available to those in need. Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation is working under the guidance of Think Foundation, Mumbai which is focused primarily on providing a structure of healthcare to patients living with Thalassemia Major, particularly those belonging to families that are financially disadvantaged. Think Foundation has a track record of more than 15 years in undertaking projects/programs for improving the quality of life of persons living with Thalassemia Major.

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#### 2. Duration of MoU

This Agreement shall be valid for a period of 3 years, unless terminated earlier by either Party, effective from September 2023 to August 2026. On completion of the term, the MOU may be further renewed upon mutual agreement.

### 3. Broad Programme Component

- · Strengthening of blood donation movement in Jharkhand.
- To create opportunities for students to engage in social fieldwork and understand the importance of giving.
- To organise Blood Donation Camp with the SOP protocol of the government.

### 4. Role of Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation

- a) To educate and sensitise all students at the college in classroom sessions with comprehensive knowledge about voluntary blood donation and the importance of safe blood.
- b) To organise blood donation drives department-wise in coordination with the Head of the Department and facilitate the same with government blood centres in Ranchi.
- c) To facilitate blood donation drives according to the best practices as per the Government's norms, SOP, and protocols, including certificates and refreshments.
- d) To facilitate an Air-conditioned blood mobile van / Donor Couches / Blood collection transportation Van for proper component donation inside the premises of the college.
- e) Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation will not only be limited to facilitating the camp but would also compile the data of deferred donors and further get the deferred donors required medical assistance.
- f) The requirement of the deferred donors would mostly be medical camps for the anaemia management or lifestyle modifications.
- g) The session on blood donation carries a great message and responsibility for donors to stay fit and health. In this effort, Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation would also keep organising anti-tobacco and anti-toxication drives in the college with the help of department of narcotics and mental health counsellors from CIP and RINPAS.
- h) Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation will facilitate drives on Thalassemia / Sickle Cell anaemia prevention in coordination with Sadar Hospital, Ranchi.
- Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation will ensure blood requirements of students/faculties from Sadar Hospital, Ranchi. There is no processing fee in government blood centre. Hence the blood received will be free of cost.

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- j) Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation will ensure Ayushman Bharat Drive for students who are ration card holders and get them golden cards with complete access to knowledge and use of various government health schemes.
- k) Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation would appraise the college about the government schemes related to health for the overall benefit of students and their families.
- Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation will encourage and mentor students to become motivators/ Ambassadors for change/ambassadors for the cause of blood donation and healthy lifestyle. The student who volunteers for this will naturally get much exposure for public speaking and overall personality development.
- m) Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation will also give certificates to students who contribute as volunteers for the blood donation movement.
- n) Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation will distribute trophies to the department which collects maximum units of blood in inter-department camps.
- o) Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation will aid in conducting various social responsibility activities to inculcate a sense of belongingness and satisfaction.
- p) Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation will liaise with various Government agencies to organise activities like, but not limited to, Tree Plantation, Cloth Distribution to the needy, Providing Education to the underprivileged, etc.
- q) JTF to facilitate and organise First Aid training session with interested students and management.
- r) JTF to create awareness on Organ Donation with National Organ & Tissue Transplant Organisation, GOJh
- s) JTF to create awareness Stem Cell Donation and organise camps as when desirable and convenient to the College Management

## 5. Role of St. Xavier's College, Ranchi

- a) St. Xavier's College to appoint a Nodal Officer to coordinate all activities with Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation.
- b) St. Xavier's College to provide a schedule/calendar for a term of 3 months / 1 Year in advance to plan for resource person for sessions.
- c) St. Xavier's College to cooperate in designating/allotting a convenient space/place for the blood donation drive.
- d) St. Xavier's College to allow space for a medical camp for the deferred donors as per their convenient date and time.
- e) St. Xavier's College to allow Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation to bring resource persons from other institutions in anti-tobacco drives / mental health drives, etc.
- f) St. Xavier's College to encourage the students become ambassadors of blood health and cause.
- g) St. Xavier's College to allow Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation to use the logo of college in flyer and posters for all events and to post it on social media for publicity of the same after due approvals.
- St. Xavier's College to issue identity cards for regular resource person for better communication and facilitation.
- St. Xavier's College student volunteers to support the work of the Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation without any financial obligation to either party.

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j) To allow the students of St. Xaviers College to be a part of the team of Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation, if they wish to be, and to help conduct blood camps at various locations from time to time and volunteer at Thalassemia / Sickle Cell Day Care Centre at Sadar Hospital, Ranchi

#### 6. Monitoring & Reporting

The volunteers shall assist the Jharkhand Thalassemia Foundation in preparing monthly monitoring reports. These reports should include the project's progress with respect to the Registry of beneficiaries, the Record of blood transfusions, Record of Chelators provided. The Report should include any activity carried out by the Centre. The volunteer, along with the Jharkhand Foundation, should also assist Day Care Centre Sadar Hospital Ranchi in maintaining the Patient Management Booklet provided for each patient. A file should be maintained for each patient, containing all Reports of Medical Investigations. The report shall be submitted to the Nodal Officer monthly. Apart from this, the volunteers and Jharkhand Foundation will also keep a record of the various social activities being organised so as to submit a report every quarter to St. Xaviers College, Ranchi.

#### 7. Financial Norms

There shall be no charge on either side for the services proposed.

#### 8. Project outcome

- > This would help 800 Thalassaemic Patients get a better quality of life.
- Students will get closer to humanitarian values and inspire them to become better human beings.
- > St. Xaviers Students/faculties will get a backup for medical help from Jharkhand Thalassaemia Foundation and Sadar Hospital, Ranchi.
- > Students from St. Xaviers College will get an opportunity for social fieldwork in a Government Hospital / Day Care Centre.
- > This MoU will not generate any financial liability to either party.
- This MoU may only be amended by a written agreement signed by a duly authorized representative of each party.
- This MOU shall commence on the date of its execution by the last Party to sign and shall remain in force for three years.
- ➤ Either Party may terminate this MOU by giving the other 3 Months' notice in writing. Terminating this MOU shall not affect the implementation of any specific activities established under it before such termination.
- Nothing in this MOU shall be construed as creating any legal relationships between the Parties. The MOU is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.
