Empowering Rural Livelihoods: Day Two of NSS Special Camp Focuses on Self-Reliance and Skill Building

The second day of the Seven Days Special Camp, organized by the National Service Scheme (NSS) units of St. Xavier's College, Ranchi, unfolded with an insightful focus on rural entrepreneurship and self-reliance. Held in the village of Kumhartoli, the day's theme revolved around equipping local communities with practical knowledge and sustainable livelihood alternatives.





The morning commenced with an engaging and hands-on training session on mushroom cultivation, led by agricultural experts. Participants were introduced to the essentials of mushroom farming—including methods of cultivation, environmental requirements, disease control techniques, and market strategies. The training aimed to familiarize villagers and youth with this low-investment, high-yield agro-practice, potentially transforming it into a profitable home-based enterprise.

The guest speakers emphasized how tapping into local resources and initiatives could help bridge the gap between dependency and self-sufficiency. They motivated the youth to take ownership of their community's future through innovation and resilience.

Local villagers participated with enthusiasm, absorbing practical knowledge and expressing a keen interest in implementing these learnings.
