No. Of Volunteers Participated:

Aim of the Event: To promote awareness on the ill effects of drug addiction on the youth of the country.

The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of St Xavier's College, Ranchi, in collaboration with Team Abhivyakti organised a impactful nukkad natak at Firayalal Chowk, aiming to raise awareness on the ill effects of drug addiction, under the theme "Nasha Mukti".
