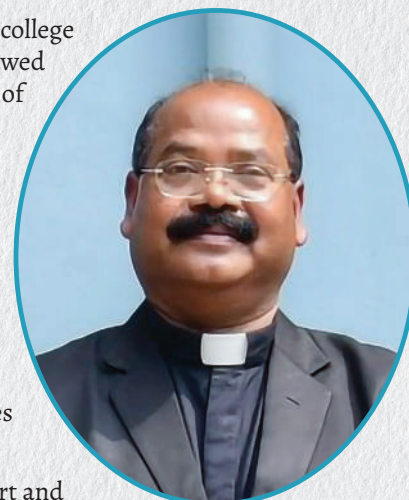

### SEMINAR ON “DIGITAL PAYMENT AWARENESS”

**Date: March 13, 2026**

**Speaker : Shri. Prem Ranjan Prasad Singh, Regional Director RBI Jharkhand**

The seminar focused on aligning participants with the RBI’s “Har Payment Digital” mission, emphasizing the transition toward a secure, less-cash economy. Experts highlighted the importance of digital financial literacy, specifically focusing on safe transaction habits through the “RBI Kehta Hai” guidelines and the use of the Integrated Ombudsman Scheme for resolving digital payment disputes. Sessions explored the evolving fintech landscape, teaching attendees how to navigate tools like UPI, UPI 123Pay, and CBDC. By integrating academic knowledge with the RBI’s regulatory framework, the seminar equipped participants with the digital competence and cybersecurity awareness essential for thriving in India’s modern banking and financial sectors. The program acted as a “Digital Career Compass,” empowering attendees to make informed financial choices and improve their workplace readiness. Participants gained a clear understanding of Zero Liability policies and the role of technology in financial inclusion, ensuring they are prepared to lead as informed users and professionals in the digital economy.



### Pre-Budget Discussion Seminar 2026–27

**Date: February 21, 2026**

Students from M. Com participated in a seminar organised by Department of Commerce and Management, Ranchi University, Ranchi. The seminar focused on youth migration and lack of local employment in Jharkhand, highlighting the paradox of a resource-rich state facing poverty and workforce outflow. It was noted that migration not only affects the economy but also disrupts the social structure. Discussions on past budgets showed that much of the expenditure is tied to fixed costs, limiting investment in job creation. The need for better utilization of funds was emphasized. A key suggestion was to redirect DMF funds towards MSMEs and local production, along with promoting district-specific MSME clusters. Improving practical, industry-linked skill development was also highlighted. The seminar identified digital jobs and agri-based startups as emerging opportunities and proposed a phased, practical approach for Budget 2026–27. Overall, it concluded that Jharkhand’s challenge is not lack of resources, but effective use of them to generate sustainable employment and reduce migration.



# Departmental Highlights

## Department of Botany

### Field Visit to Birsa Munda Museum and Memorial Park

Date : March 10, 2026

Purpose: A field visit was conducted by the Department of Botany, St. Xavier's College, Ranchi for the students of M.Sc. Botany (Taxonomy) to study the plant diversity in the Birsa Munda Museum and Memorial Park. The main objective was to identify and document various plant species, understand their habitats, habit and their taxonomical characteristics.

#### Objective :

1. To study the floristic diversity present in the Park Ecosystem.
2. To identify and classify plant species using morphological characteristics.
3. To observe the vegetation structure including trees, shrubs, herbs and climbers.
4. To understand the role of urban green species in biodiversity conservation.
5. To observe the various taxonomical characteristics of the plant like Inflorescence etc.

#### Methodology:

**Field observation:** Plant were observed directly in their natural growing conditions and tree and shrubs were noted down their genus, Species and the family they belong to.

**Morphological Identifications:** Identification was based on vegetative and reproductive features such as leaf shape, flower structure, stem characteristics and growth habit.

**Photographic Documentation:** Photographs of pant species and habitats were taken for future reference.

**Quadrant Study:** Note were taken regarding plant abundance, frequencies and density of herbs.



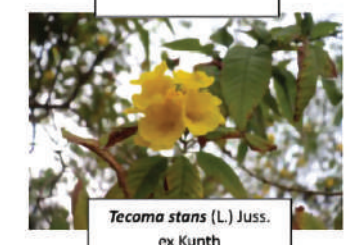
**Conclusion:** The field visit provided valuable insights into the diversity of plant species present in an Urban Park ecosystem. A variety of trees, shrubs, herbs and climbers were observed, demonstrating the ecological complexity of even small green spaces.

The six-day Faculty Development Programme (FDP) held from 23rd to 28th March 2026 at St. Xavier's College, Ranchi, was organized by the Department of Economics in collaboration with IQAC and ISI New Delhi. The programme focused on enhancing research skills through lectures on research methodology, ethics, data analysis, and publication techniques. Experts from reputed institutions conducted sessions, including hands-on training in SPSS and guidance on identifying research gaps. Special emphasis was placed on indigenous research methodologies and field-based learning through a study visit. The FDP concluded with a valedictory session, certificate distribution, and encouragement for advancing academic research and innovation among participants.

# Departmental Highlights

## Department of Geology



### Field Trip Report Date: March 23, 2026

The Department of Geology, St. Xavier's College, Ranchi organized a five-day geological field trip to the Visakhapatnam–Araku Valley corridor, Andhra Pradesh, on 26 February 2026 for B.Sc. and M.Sc. students as part of their Major Practical and Field Study programme. A total of 102 students, accompanied by Ms. Mable M. Toppo, Dr. Somesh Sengupta, and Dr. Melvin A. Ekka, participated.

The field study focused on the Eastern Ghats Mobile Belt, a Precambrian orogenic belt known for high-grade metamorphic rocks, tectonic structures, and varied geomorphology. The objectives included studying regional geology, identifying rocks such as khondalites and charnockites, observing structural features like foliation, folds, joints, shear zones, and boudinage, examining coastal geomorphology, Quaternary sediments, karst topography, and developing field mapping and interpretative skills.

Key observations were made at Kailasagiri Hills, where khondalite rocks with foliation, joints, pinch-and-swell structures, and stress shadows indicated tectono-metamorphic activity. At Erra Matti Dibbalu, students examined Quaternary red sand deposits shaped by aeolian and fluvial processes. Coastal studies at Bheemunipatnam and Kapuluppada revealed sea cliffs, caves, arches, stacks, and heavy mineral concentrations of ilmenite, garnet, and magnetite. At Borra Caves, limestone karst features such as stalactites, stalagmites, pillars, and flowstones highlighted speleogenesis and groundwater action. Chaparai Water Cascade demonstrated fluvial erosion and differential weathering.

The trip significantly enhanced students' understanding of Precambrian geology, tectonics, geomorphology, and field techniques while strengthening teamwork, documentation, and scientific reporting skills. Cultural visits to museums, beaches, tribal centres, and heritage sites enriched the overall educational experience.

### Field Trip Report Date: February 12, 2026

The Department of Geology organized a two-day Geological Field Training Program in collaboration with the Geological Survey of India (GSI), State Unit Ranchi, at Bharno Block, Gumla District, Jharkhand, on 8th and 12th February 2026. Guided by Mrs. Anita Kabi and Dr. Laxmikant, postgraduate students studied Precambrian rock formations, quartzite–granite gneiss contacts, structural features, weathering processes, and intrusive rocks at Basiya and Ambera villages. Practical demonstrations included heavy mineral separation through jigging, stream sediment sampling, and soil analysis. The program enhanced students' understanding of Chotanagpur Granite Gneiss Complex geology, field mapping, structural interpretation, and mineral exploration techniques.

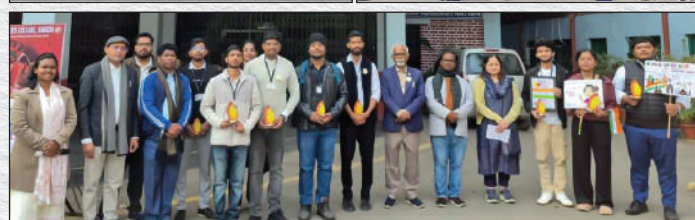

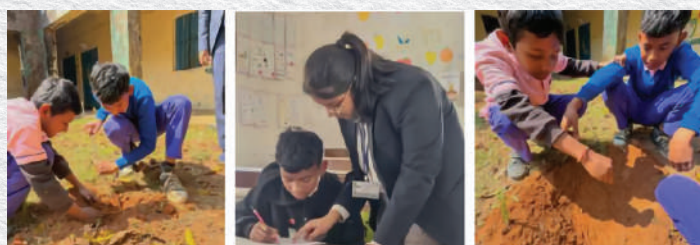


### Rotaract Club

## Academic Calendar October-December 2025

### January 2026
