Event: Seminar on "Out migration from

Jharkhand"

On August 7, 2025, Department of Geography, St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Ranchi, organized a one-day seminar on "Out Migration from Jharkhand: Macro and Micro Perspective." The resource person for the event was Dr. Kunal Kesari, an alumnus of St. Xavier's College, Ranchi. Dr. Kesari delivered an insightful lecture focusing on the demographic aspects and nature of migration from Jharkhand, supported by relevant statistical data. He elaborated on the distinctions between seasonal or temporary migration and permanent migration, critically analyzing their underlying causes and push factors. The talk also highlighted how migration contributes to urbanization and examined the large-scale return of migrant workers during the COVID-19 pandemic. Quoting Dr. Kesari said, "We are born once, we die once, but we can move many times,". The session underscored the dynamic and multifaceted nature of migration. The seminar proved to be highly informative - offering participants a deeper and critical understanding of migration trends and their socio-economic implications. Faculty members and students from both undergraduate and postgraduate programs attended the session. A total of 109 participants were present, making the event a successful and enriching academic experience.


The remarkable achievement of our alumni demonstrates the department's role in shaping holistic education that extends beyond Geology into civil services, inspiring current students to pursue excellence.

The session was delivered by Sri Sanjay Sinha, IFS (Retd.), Former Member Secretary, JSPCB & SEAC, Jharkhand, and was attended by students, research scholars, and professionals.

Objective: To impart an in-depth understanding of the legal, regulatory, and technical framework of forest clearance in India, with special emphasis on mineral exploration and mining activities.

Outcome: Participants gained practical insights into clearance procedures, borehole execution norms, and compliance obligations, equipping them with knowledge to bridge geological exploration with environmental governance.

Location: Sikni Coal Mines, Auranga Coal Basin, Latehar District, Jharkhand

As part of the FYUGP—NEP curriculum for the Industry-Academia Project (IAP) paper and field training component, students of B.Sc. Semester V and M.Sc. Semester III participated in a field visit to Sikni Coal Mines, located in the Auranga Coal Basin, Latehar district, Jharkhand.

The field training aimed at providing students with practical exposure to coalfield Geology, lithological variations, structural settings, and the stratigraphic framework of coal-bearing formations. The Sikni coal mine, operated by the Jharkhand State Mineral Development Corporation Limited (JSMDC), forms part of the easternmost Gondwana coal basins of the North Koel Valley and represents an ideal site to study the Geology of the Barakar Formation, the principal coal-bearing unit of the region.


Event: International Ozone Day


