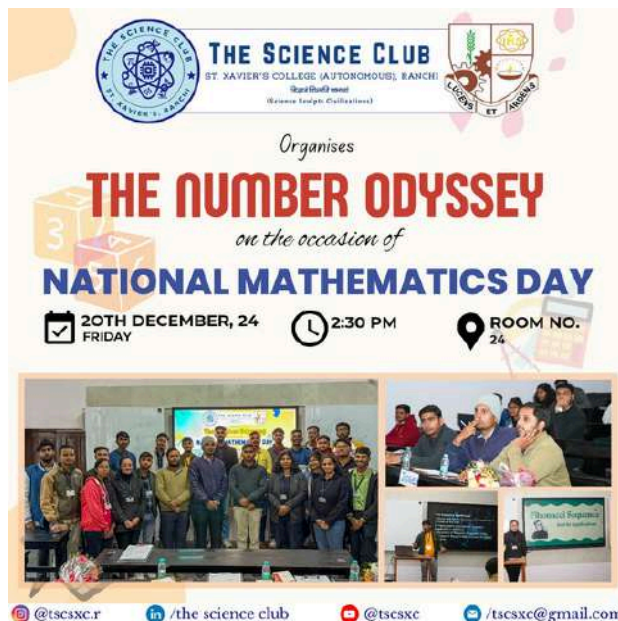
Project Name - Announcement Of BOG's

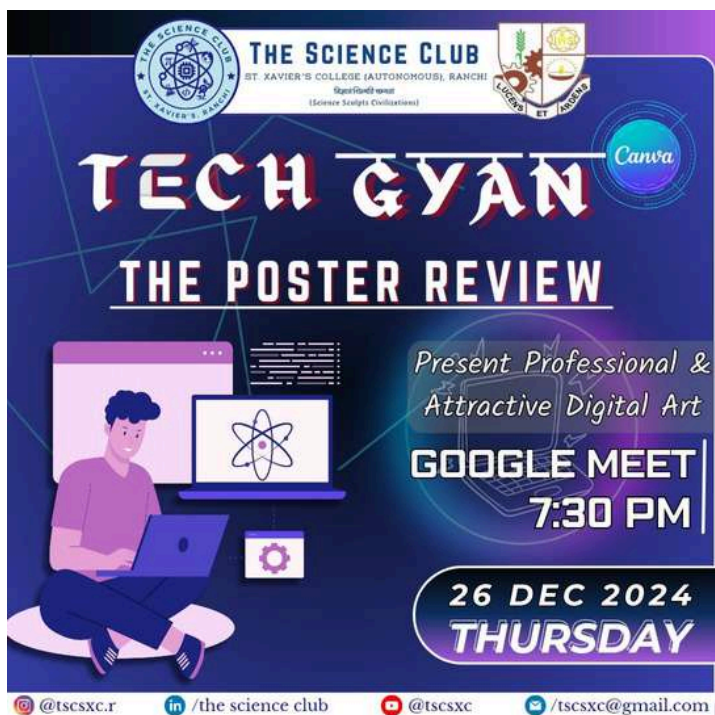
