
## Add-On Certificate Course on Industrial Bioprocess Technology

## About the Course

Bioprocess technology is the industrial application by using the living organism or their components to produce valuable product e.g. enzymes, organic acid, antibiotics, fermented food etc. The major advantages of bioprocesses over traditional chemical processes are that they are simple, cost effective, require only few steps reaction conditions, more specific and efficient in term of products, and produce renewable by-products.

The aim of this course is to reduce the gap between academician and industry by providing research and job opportunity in industries. This course will provide the students a short training programme related to fermentation and industrial products. This certificate course including, hands-on-training, practical and industrial visits will defiantly provide a mile-stone for industrial job opportunity.
