OBJECTIVES:-



- Live singing was performed.




















OBJECTIVES:-

 lasting change.



- The official Letter of Exchange was presented by the respective club presidents/coordinators.


OUTCOME:-

- · Enhanced sense of community, teamwork, and inter-collegiate engagement among participants.


CONCLUSION:-

- Important design principles such as color harmony, clarity of text, aesthetic layout, and brand elements (including removing logo backgrounds) were explained


