- Build a strong, dynamic, and dedicated team that will actively participate in and enhance club initiatives.




OUTCOME:-



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EMPYREAN CLUB CASE STUDY REPORT (JANUARY 2025 - AUGUST 2025)

Title: How Clubs, Societies, and NGOs Serve as Catalysts for Academic and Personal Development

INTRODUCTION:-

The Empyrean Club of St. Xavier's College, Ranchi, conducted a comprehensive case study between January 2025 and August 2025 to examine the multifaceted role of clubs, societies, and NGOs in fostering both academic and personal development among college students. The study was motivated by the recognition that extracurricular engagement is a vital component of holistic education, shaping not only academic performance but also interpersonal, organizational, and leadership skills.

OBJECTIVES OF THE STUDY:-

The primary objectives of the study were to:

- 1. Assess the extent and nature of student participation in clubs, societies, and NGOs.
- 2. Evaluate how such participation contributes to students' academic performance.
- 3. Explore the impact of extracurricular involvement on personal skill development.
- 4. Identify the challenges students face in maintaining participation.
- 5. Gather student suggestions to enhance the effectiveness of such organizations.







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RESEARCH METHODOLOGY:-

The study employed a survey-based primary data collection method. A structured questionnaire was developed, incorporating both closed-ended and open-ended questions to ensure a balanced quantitative and qualitative analysis.

Survey Components:

- Membership status in clubs, societies, and NGOs.
- Frequency and nature of participation in organizational activities.
- Motivations for joining (e.g., networking, leadership, skill enhancement).
- Perceived influence on academic performance.
- Personal growth and skill development outcomes.
- Challenges encountered during participation.
- Suggestions for improvement and better engagement.

<u>Sample and Data Collection:</u>

A total of N = 301 valid responses were collected from students of St. Xavier's College, Ranchi. Participants represented a diverse mix of academic disciplines and years of study, ensuring a holistic view of student experiences.

<u>Data Analysis:</u>

Quantitative data were analyzed using descriptive statistics (percentages, frequencies) to identify patterns and trends.

Qualitative responses—especially open-ended feedback and personal reflections—were thematically analyzed to capture deeper insights into students' perceptions and lived experiences.















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KEY FINDINGS:-

Academic Development:

The study found a strong positive correlation between active participation in extracurricular organizations and academic outcomes. Students who engaged frequently reported enhanced communication skills, greater confidence, exposure to diverse perspectives, and improved time management.

<u>Personal Development:</u>

Participation also contributed significantly to personal growth, including leadership and teamwork skills, networking ability, empathy, and problem-solving.

Challenges Identified:

Students noted time constraints, limited institutional support, resource shortages, and lack of structured mentorship.

Suggestions for Improvement:

Better scheduling coordination, institutional incentives, leadership training, and collaboration between clubs and NGOs.

DISCUSSION:-

The findings reaffirm that extracurricular engagement is not merely an optional aspect of college life, but a crucial contributor to holistic student development. Clubs, societies, and NGOs act as catalysts for experiential learning, bridging theoretical knowledge with real-world application.









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CONCLUSION:-

The study concludes that participation in clubs, societies, and NGOs significantly enhances both academic performance and personal development. By fostering leadership, communication, and civic engagement, these organizations shape well-rounded individuals prepared for academic excellence and societal contribution.

RECOMMENDATIONS:-


- 1. Establish stronger institutional frameworks to support student organizations.
